If, for any reason, a student is not accepted the deposit is, of course, refunded. We advise students to take out independent cancellation insurance to protect against loss in the event of illness, injury, jury service and other difficulties preventing the completion of a course. You would receive back your deposit and any other fees paid in advance to the Temple in full in the event of The Glastonbury Goddess Temple cancelling the course for any reason.
- 3. By signing this agreement you confirm that we may keep on file the details you have given us in your application for the training and any subsequent communications. We will keep your details for no more than seven years from your application. It's also important that we are able to get in touch with you quickly during the run up to the beginning of the training and throughout the life of the course, and you therefore also agree to us contacting you by email, regular mail, telephone or SMS. You must inform of us any change in contact details.
- 4. Course fees are to be paid in full prior to the course start date or by deposit paid as in clause 2 above, followed by 5 instalments, by standing order or by PayPal (four monthly instalment payments involve an additional one-off fee of £30 covering Paypal or banking costs). Late payment of instalments without pre-arranged good cause may result in a fine of £5 per late payment. You also need to inform us if you're paying by instalments and change your method of payment during the course, otherwise we incur additional admin fees which may also need to be passed on to you.
